Fr Simon writes: Fr Simon writes: Continuing the reflection on St Claude de la Colombiere, it is worth remembering that the relics of both St Claude la Colombiere and St Margaret Mary Alacoque were welcomed to London as part of a Sacred Heart of Mercy Mission from 9 to 13 November 2016. The visit was led by missionaries from the Emmanuel Community in collaboration with the parishes of Farm Street, Soho Square and Our Lady of Victories, Kensington. At a Mass to welcome the relics, Bishop John Wilson (Archbishop of Southwark) reflected on the love story the mission celebrates: *'The love in this story is older than the heavens, but it's as fresh as the present moment. The love in this story stretches wider than the entire human race, but it's as personal as you and me...God's tremendous love comes through Jesus Christ, whose Sacred Heart is beating now to pump mercy throughout the whole of creation.'*

Catechism in the Cluster: 2026-2027

Deacon Gary's Tuesday Catechism Class: This class will resume on 15th September and takes place on every Tuesday during the school terms. It is for any member of the congregation between the age of 11 and 16 who for whatever reason have not received one or other of the Sacraments of Initiation. The Sacraments of Initiation are Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion. To enrol in the Class, please collect an enrolment form either from Deacon Gary after Mass or from the Parish Office. Please return it after completion to the Parish Office. The Rite of Enrolment will take place for those who have enrolled on Sunday 18th October at the 09.30 Mass.

Sunday Morning Catechism for First Holy Communion for those not in Catholic Schools: We are very grateful to Loretto and Tracey Cattell who for many years now have shouldered the responsibility for preparing the parish children aged 7/8 who are not in any of our Catholic Primary Schools for First Holy Communion. Loretto has decided that it is time for her to retire. We are currently approaching a number of parishioners to take over from her. We are committed to maintaining the programme after the schools return from their Summer break. Please look out for further announcements.

Initiation of Christian Adults: We have had several enquiries from adults who are either already baptised or who are not yet baptised but in either case wish to become Catholics. Over the next few weeks, we ask all interested parties to complete an enrolment form and then we can discuss how best to make provision to meet this important pastoral need.

Updating our understanding of the Church's teaching on Our Lady

We may think there is nothing new to say about Our Lady, but Rome thinks otherwise. The Vatican has relatively recently published a new document clarifying a number of points. Pope Leo's concern is that there are still too many of us who have not kept pace with the development of the Church's teaching on the place of the Blessed Virgin Mary within the Church. During the month of October, Deacon Gary will post three videos on the new Sacred Heart and St. John Henry Newman website for you to read whenever convenient. He will then offer the opportunity for anyone who wishes to raise questions to meet with him on 22nd October at 19:00 in the CTK Guild Room
